* New School Online Payment System *

Commencing Tuesday, 3rd November school will be introducing a new online payment system called SCHOOLMONEY which will allow you to pay for all school related items (school dinners, trips etc.) online using a debit/credit card. You should have received a text message last Wednesday which contained a password for logging onto the SCHOOLMONEY website. This password will give you access to your SCHOOLMONEY account. You can

then begin to make online payments to school. This new payment system will benefit both us as a school and you as a parent. Not only will you be able to pay for items from the comfort of your own home, but you will also be able to access your account at any time to see if there is anything you need to pay for. A letter has been uploaded onto our school app under LETTERS/INFORMATION giving full details on how to access your account. However, if you are unable to access the letter, copies are available from the school office.

REMINDER: if you pay for your child's school dinners, PLEASE DO NOT SEND DINNER MONEY IN AFTER HALF TERM as the office is no longer accepting cash. You will be sent a notification to pay online. If you experience any problems setting up your account or making payments, please contact the school office.

Times Tables Rock Stars and Numbots

As well as Times Tables Rock Stars (Y2-Y6), we would like to make parents/carers aware that we have negotiated the use of Numbots for a trial period until October half term. Numbots is an online platform that increases addition and subtraction knowledge and can be accessed using your child's Times Tables Rock Stars username and password.



Home Learning

Children who are isolating should be accessing home learning every weekday through the online platform Purple Mash. Their teachers are providing daily lessons (2dos) and information about each lesson via the Purple Mash blog. Please help your child login so they can continue to learn.
