

\*School Online Payment System \*

On Tuesday, 3rd November we introduced a new online payment system called SCHOOLMONEY which will allow you to pay for all school related items (school dinners, trips etc.) online using a debit/credit card. You should have received a text message last Wednesday which contained a password for logging onto the SCHOOLMONEY website. This password will give you access to

your **SCHOOLMONEY** account. You can then begin to make online payments to school. This new payment system will benefit both us as a school and you as a parent. Not only will you be able to pay for items from the comfort of your own home, but you will also be able to access your account at any time to see if there is anything you need to pay for. A letter has been uploaded onto our school app under

LETTERS/INFORMATION giving full details on how to access your account. However, if you are unable to access the letter, copies are available from the school office. REMINDER: if you pay for your child's school dinners, PLEASE DO NOT SEND DINNER MONEY as the office is

no longer accepting cash. If you experience any problems setting up your account or making payments, please contact the school office
