Nursery

This week in Nursery our story was The Three Little Pigs. The children were introduced to the characters and role played the story. We discussed the materials and which was the strongest to build a house. Each child made their own spider by cutting two pipe cleaners in half to make four pieces, we folded them again to make 8 legs. After adding a body and eyes they attached it to their spider's web. In the KS1 Hall we further developed our physical skills by jumping from a higher box after balancing along a steeper bench. Children were taught how to land safely. This week they crawled or slid under a pole.

The children have been learning little rhymes which will help as they form their numbers.

As well as revisiting all our previous sounds, we have been focusing on the letter 'h': Horse: Down the body to the hooves, up and over his back.

Thank you to all the parents and carers who have helped their child to find objects beginning with our sound of the week. Some objects this week are hat, horse, The Hulk and Hercules.
