# Early Years Foundation Stage Weekly Newsletter Friday 20th May 2022 <br> Nursery 

This week in Nursery our story was The Amazing Life Cycle of Butterflies. The children were fascinated as they watched the caterpillars attach themselves to the container and spin a chrysalis. In the KS1 Hall we further developed our physical skills and the children used the prepositions as they climbed on, balanced along and jumped off the bench. They jumped down from a high box. Children crawled under or jumped over a pole. They threw beanbags into hoops. Using beanbags we taught the children to play Piggy in the Middle. Enjoying the fine weather the children went on nature walk in the school grounds to observe and record the features in the local environment.

As well as revisiting all our previous sounds, we have been focusing on the letter
' $r$ ': Robot: Down his back and curl over his arm.
The children have been finding objects in the sound bag and sorting them by their initial sounds and often matching them to the initial letter.
Thank you to all the parents and carers who have helped their child to find objects beginning with our sound of the week. Some objects this week are receipt, rabbit and robot.
